Isolation & Quarantine Guidance

If You Test **POSITIVE** for
COVID-19
(regardless of vaccination status)

If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can leave your house. Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.

If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.

If You were **EXPOSED** to COVID-19 & are **Boosted** OR vaccinated < 6 months ago with Pfizer or Moderna or < 2 months ago with J&J vaccine

Wear a mask around others for 10 days. Test on day 5, if possible.

If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home.

If You were **EXPOSED** to COVID-19 & are **Unvaccinated** OR Vaccinated > 6 months ago with Pfizer or Moderna or > 2 months ago with J&J vaccine

Stay home for 5 days. After that continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days. Test on day 5, if possible.

If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home.

Keep safe.

Wear a mask and consider getting vaccinated.

All vaccinations at JCHD now require an appointment. Vaccinations occur Monday - Friday 8:30am - 3:30pm and Tuesday 8:30am - 5:30pm. No fees are collected and no insurance information is needed for COVID-19 vaccines at JCHD.
