FIFTEEN NEW COVID-19 CASES REPORTED IN JACKSON COUNTY

Jackson County Health Department was notified in the past 24 hours of fifteen Jackson County residents confirmed to have contracted COVID-19. The individuals are as follows:

- Female – three teens, seven in their twenties, and one in her seventies;
- Male – two in their twenties, and two in their fifties.

They acquired the disease either through contact with known cases or through transmission in the community (i.e., unable to trace back to a known source). They are being placed in isolation.

One hundred forty-four active cases are currently being managed. To date, there have been 1,121 confirmed cases in the county, including 24 related deaths. Twelve individuals were released from isolation, in accordance with CDC guidelines, bringing the total released to 953 individuals. All data are preliminary and subject to change.

If you have a fever, cough, difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle aches, loss of taste or smell, nausea, diarrhea or other symptoms, call your health care provider for further guidance. Two providers are conducting COVID-19 testing of eligible individuals in Jackson County: Southern Illinois Healthcare (SIH) – Call 1-844-988-7800; and Shawnee Health Service – Call 618-519-9200. Call one of them, or your healthcare provider, to inquire about getting tested.
