Public Health Environmentalist / Sanitarian

Full time position for an enthusiastic individual with strong communication and critical thinking skills. With the ability to effectively and professionally provide inspections, enforcement and education in a variety of environmental public health programs.

Hours: Full time equals 35 hours per week with full benefits.

Minimum Educational Requirements: Requires Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with a minimum of 30 semester hours or 45 quarter hours in life, natural, physical or health sciences.

Key job duties include:

- Conduct routine environmental health program inspections including, but not limited to, programs in food sanitation, potable water supplies, private sewage disposal, solid waste, nuisance control, and insect and rodent control.
- Assist and makes collections of data, documentary evidence, etc. for use in prosecution of cases of non-compliance and epidemiological investigations.
- Understand state laws, local ordinances, rules and regulations; offer guidance on sanitation practices and principles; advises regarding improvements or corrections necessary to assure compliance with applicable laws, rules and regulations.
- Collect, analyze, and interpret data and make reasoned recommendations.
- Handle conflict and confrontation in a firm, professional manner suggestive of solutions.
- Participate in emergency response activities as assigned for both exercises and actual events.
- Incorporate ethical standards of practice into all interactions, including the use of data and information.
- Adhere to HIPAA privacy regulations and OSHA safety standards pertaining to exposure to toxic substances or other hazards.
